## **Subdivisions & Land Development Plans**

Miller, Amos H & Mary Ann

299 Aubel Road, Map BO Parcel 18, 3-acre subdivision proposal.

They propose to subdivide 3 acres from property. Son Issac presented map showing the parcel he hoped to subdivide; no formal plan was presented. Miller requests that the 3 acres includes some good quality ground; not only poor-quality ground as the township zoning ordinance requires. The soils map was reviewed by several members. Discussion was held in reference to the ability of the land to be efficiently farmed. It was suggested that Miller document hardships in an effort to request an exemption to the Zoning Hearing Board. Much discussion on keeping to the ordinance requirements.

Proposed Amendment – Zoning Ordinance Section 339A - Principal Solar Energy Systems Change \$2,000.00 per megawatt of capacity to \$2,360.00 per megawatt to be adjusted yearly instead of every 5 years to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index.

The attorney explained the intent of the ordinance that was adopted in 2020, after some discussion.
